Can you believe summer is almost here? It seems like yesterday that we started this school year. It has been quite a busy year in the clinic and I have thoroughly enjoyed caring for your children.

As we near the end of the school year please remember to come by the clinic to pick up any medication that your child has in the clinic. All medications should be picked up from the clinic by May 25, 2017. School policy does not allow for medication to remain in the school over the summer. It will be important for you to make arrangements to pick up your child's medication since it may not go home with the student. Any medications left in the clinic after May 25, 2017 will be discarded according to policy.

The Medication Authorization form and Medical Management Plans are found on the clinic web page if needed for next year. As you know, medication orders must be completed every school year whether your child remains in the same school or attends another. If your child has a physical examination during the summer months, this is a good time to get the medication forms completed. These forms are good for any school in St. Johns County district.

For your convenience, the clinic will be open beginning August 2, 2017, (one week prior to the first day of school for students), to accept your child's medication and completed medication forms. I will also be at each of the Wolf Greetings to assist you.
