<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must be a 5<sup>th</sup> grader for the 2022-2023 School Year</li> <li>No grade below 75</li> <li>Complete all homework and class work in a timely manner</li> <li>Maintain a good attendance record</li> <li>Good behavior on the bus or at school</li> <li>Highly-rated teacher recommendation</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Arrive to duty <b>on time</b> (attendance taken daily).</li> <li>Be a <b>leader</b> by <b>always</b> setting a good example.</li> <li>Demonstrate the 3 R's (responsible, respectful, and ready to learn)</li> <li>Maintain a 75 average or higher in each class.</li> <li>Assist other <b>elementary students</b> at LPA so they are <b>safe</b>.</li> <li>Wear patrol belt at all times while on duty.</li> </ul>

\*\*\*Failure to comply with safety patrol criteria/responsibilities will result in a suspension or dismissal from safety patrol duties\*\*\*

**All patrol members with morning duty must arrive no later than 7:45 a.m.** The patrol will be counted tardy or absent if they are not on time. **All patrol members on afternoon duty will report to their post at 2:40. (1:40 on Wed.)** IF SELECTED, patrols must attend a mandatory training session prior to patrolling and pay **program dues of \$15 (updated cost for 2022-2023 SY—will also include a t-shirt), dues to be paid no later than Aug. 19, 2022.** More information, including mandatory training for patrols will be emailed to parents on Aug. 12 by 3 pm.
